Private Pilot Licence (PPL)

Waterloo Wellington Flight Centre professional programs are approved as a vocational programs under the Private Career Colleges Act, 2005 (PCC#105919).

Requirements

- Minimum 17 years of age (14 years of age for first solo)
- Valid Category 1, 3 Medical Certificate
- Completed WWFC Customer Application
- Completed WWFC Rules & Regulations Package

Knowledge

An applicant for a Private Pilot Licence – Aeroplane shall have completed a minimum of 40 hours private pilot aeroplane ground school instruction including mandatory subject areas. An applicant shall have obtained a minimum of 60% on the written examination for Private Pilot Licence – Aeroplane (PPAER). The Study and Reference Guide is available at:

Experience

An applicant shall have completed a minimum of:

- 45 hours total flight time, of which a maximum of five hours may be completed in an approved flight-training device.
- 17 hours dual instruction flight time, including three hours of cross-country flight time and five hours of instrument time (three hours may be approved simulator ground time).
- 12 hours solo flight time, including five hours of cross-country flight time, including a flight of a minimum of 150 nautical miles which shall include two full stop landings at points other than the point of departure.

Skill

An applicant shall successfully complete a flight test to the standard outlined in the Flight Test Standards – Private Licence – Aeroplane (TP13723E) available at:

Privileges

The holder of a Private Pilot Licence – Aeroplane may:

- Act as pilot-in-command or co-pilot of an aeroplane of a class and type in respect of which the licence is endorsed with ratings
- Act as pilot-in-command of an ultra-light aeroplane
