Requirements

- Valid PPL, CPL or ATPL
- Group 1 or 3 rating
- Valid Category 1 or 3 Medical Certificate
- Completed WWFC Customer Application
- Completed WWFC Rules and Regulations Package

Knowledge

A strong grasp of instrument flying, IFR flight planning, including weather analysis, alternate airports, and current IFR regulations. The IPC requires no letter of recommendation from a flight instructor, it must be understood that applicants provide a self-assessed timeline of how long it will take to be ready for the Transport Canada examination. An applicant shall complete 1-5 dual simulator flights in either our Alsim or Alsim 250. No minimum or maximum time is allocated towards this service, only as much as the applicant requires.
