

Flight Instructor Rating (FIR) – Class 4

Approved as a vocational program under the Ontario Career Colleges Act, 2005 (PCC#105919).

Requirements

- Valid CPL or ATPL
- Valid Category 1 Medical Certificate
- Completed WWFC Customer Application
- Completed WWFC Rules & Regulations Package
- Completed Ontario Career College Contract

Knowledge

An applicant for an Instructor Rating – Class 4 shall complete 25 hours of ground school including mandatory subject areas. An applicant shall have obtained a minimum of 70% on the written examination (AIRAF). The study and reference guide (TP2810) is available at:

Experience

An applicant shall have completed a minimum of 30 hours dual instruction, including five hours in the teaching of instrument flying skills.

Skill

An applicant shall successfully complete a flight test to the standard outlined in the Flight Test Standard – Instructor Rating (TP 5537E) available at: <http://www.tc.gc.ca/eng/civilaviation/publications/tp5537-menu-4281.htm>

Privileges

The holder of an Instructor Rating – Class 4 may instruct students while employed and supervised at a Flight Training Unit.
