

VFR Over the Top Rating (VFR OTT)

This program does not require approval under the *Ontario Career Colleges Act, 2005*

Requirements

- Valid Private Pilot Licence
- Valid appropriate Medical Certificate
- Completed WWFC Customer Application
- Completed WWFC Rules & Regulations Package

Knowledge

Satisfactory knowledge displayed to your instructor.

Experience

An applicant shall have completed a minimum of 15 hours of dual instrument time of which a maximum of five hours may be instrument ground time.

Skill

An applicant for a VFR OTT rating shall have demonstrated to their instructor the level of skill specified in the Flight Instructor Guide – VFR OTT.

Privileges

The holder of a VFR OTT rating may operate aeroplanes endorsed on their licence over top of cloud while maintaining visual reference to the horizon. Conditions at the point of departure and arrival must adhere to certain VFR weather minimums.
