**GIRLS CAN FLY - Waterloo Wellington Flight Centre Event May 11, 2019**  
**AGREEMENT TO WAIVE LIABILITY, ASSUME RISK, AND INDEMNIFY;**  
**RELEASE FOR USE OF PHOTOS AND IMAGES**

The person listed below (The " Participant") wants to take part in this Waterloo Wellington Flight Centre (WWFC) event including riding in an airplane or helicopter or volunteering. This WWFC event is conducted by volunteer member pilots who are licensed by the Transport Canada. These volunteer pilots fly a wide variety of aircraft that are also licensed by the Transport Canada. I represent and warrant that I am over eighteen (18) years of age and, if applicable, the Participant's parent or legal guardian and that I have the authority to enter into this agreement, or on behalf of the Participant. In exchange for being allowed to take part in the WWFC event, the Participant or parent or legal guardian of the participant agrees as follows:

**ASSUMPTION OF RISK**

The Participant or parent/legal guardian (if Participant is under eighteen (18) years of age), understand that flying in airplanes or helicopters and being around airplanes involves risks. Serious injury or death can result from many causes, including without limitation airplane or helicopter crashes, falls, pilot error, ground crew error, engine or mechanical failure, negligent maintenance, defects in runways, interference by wildlife and other objects, difficult search and rescue conditions, inadequate emergency response, weather or terrain conditions, contaminated fuel, or hard or forced landings. Injuries could be minor such as bruises, scratches and sprains, major such as eye injuries, broken bones and concussions, or catastrophic such as paralysis, severe burns or death. If the Participant is old enough to understand these risks, I have explained them to him or her.

The Participant and parent/legal guardian (if applicable) (for ourselves, our heirs, family members, personal representatives and assigns) assume all risks and full responsibility for any injury or death arising from taking part in the Women of Aviation Worldwide event including riding in an airplane.

**AGREEMENT TO WAIVE LIABILITY AND NOT TO SUE**

The Participant and parent/legal guardian (if applicable) (for ourselves, our heirs, family members, personal representatives and assigns) release and discharge: (a) Waterloo-Wellington Flight Centre; (b) Great Lakes Helicopter and (c) officers, directors, members, chapters, employees, agents, divisions, affiliates and volunteers ( including without limitation pilots, owners and operators of airplanes or helicopters used in the WWFC event (collectively, the" Releasees") from, and agree not to sue the Releasees or any of them for, any and all claims against any of the Releasees for any injury or death arising from the Participant' s participation in the WWFC event. This release, discharge and agreement not to sue applies to all my legal rights, including those resulting from any negligence of Releasees.

**INDEMNIFICATION**

The Participant and parent/legal guardian (if applicable) agree to indemnify and hold the Releasees harmless from any claims, costs, damages, and liabilities, including attorney's fees, arising from taking part in the WWFC event. This duty to indemnify and hold the Releasees harmless applies even if any of the Releasees is negligent.

**PHOTO AND IMAGE RELEASE**

The Participant and parent/legal guardian (if applicable) hereby give the Releasees the absolute and irrevocable right and permission to use photographs, pictures and/or images of the Participant taken at or derived from his or her participation in the WWFC event (the " Images") in whole or in part, with or without alteration or modification, in any and/ or all manner and in any and/ or all media, in connection with Waterloo-Wellington Flight Centre's activities, programs, publications and publicity.

**LEGAL ADVICE**

I know that I can talk to my legal advisor about this Agreement and I have either done so or chosen not to. I understand that I have the right and have been given the opportunity to object to and bargain about the provisions of this Agreement. I am voluntarily signing this Agreement and intend it to be the unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law.

**Before Signing, Carefully Read This Entire Agreement**

Note from the Waterloo Wellington Flight Centre: If an accident were to occur, the Participant and parent/legal guardian (if applicable) (by signing this Agreement) would be giving up legal rights and potentially incurring legal liabilities. If any part of this Agreement is held invalid, the rest of the provisions shall remain in effect. If you do not understand anything in this Agreement, you should not sign it and you should talk to your legal advisor.
